Women Deacons

Two years ago, at the request of the major female Religious Superiors, the Pope asked for a special study to be undertaken about the possibility of women deacons in the Church. The theologians have now reported back, but the findings seem to be inconclusive and they seem to have divergent views. The Pope has said that the report recognises without doubt that there were women deacons in the early Church who were called to take on tasks and works of service and ministry. The problem appears to be that there is nothing conclusive to say whether it was recognised as an ordained ministry. Some of the scholars say that there is evidence of prayers, or an ordination ceremony, while others disagree. Pope Francis has called on further studies to be made into this area.

German Bishops

The German Bishops are in discussion with the Vatican about the spouses of Catholics, who are not Catholic, being allowed o receive Holy Communion. If it is to be allowed the person would have to have a Catholic belief in the Eucharist. No decision has yet been reached.
