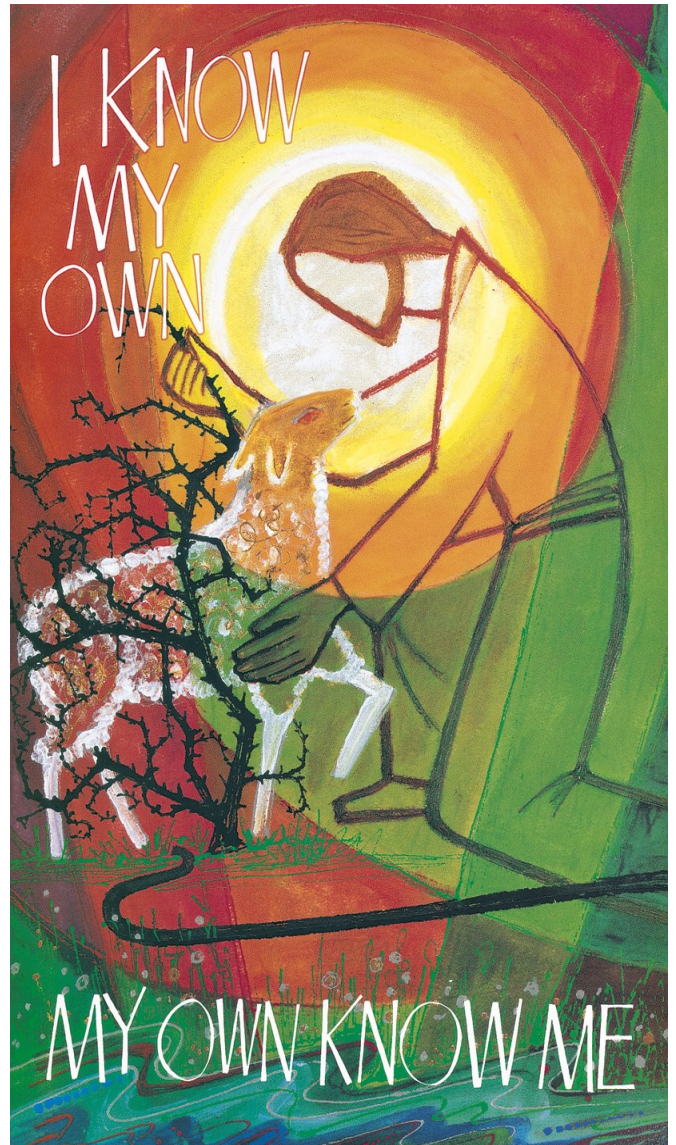

Consultation

South Lanarkshire Council is holding a consultation regarding parking in the town. New Property

The property that we are interested in buying was originally a subscription school built in 1848. This means that originally it would have been paid for by public subscription. It was built in a period in which many of the Reformed Churches were active in the education and formation of the young. It is believed that this is the oldest school building in Cambuslang. It has a status B which means that any work done on it would have to be approved by Heritage specialists. This week a report on the condition of the building will be in our hands and we will make a decision, based on that, how to proceed with the project.
